Halloween Costumes-Pictures,

Please! As we get closer to everyone's favorite dress-up holiday, please remember that costumes

We will be talking a lot about Halloween and the children love to talk about their costumes, so if you have a picture that you can share of your child in their Halloween costume (from this year or another) send it in. We'll be sharing them at circle time and taping them up on our blackboard to make a "Halloween Parade" for us to enjoy this month.

Printed photos are preferred, but you can email them in if you don't have easy access to a printer.

Extra Clothes Bag Restock With the weather cooling down, it's time to check those extra clothes bags and make sure they're stocked with long sleeves and pants instead of t-shirts and shorts.

It's also always a good idea to have a sweatshirt or sweater in your child's coat cubby that can stay at school during the week.

Many children get cold after nap and it's nice to have an extra layer of clothing close at hand.



Snack Portions Please be mindful of the amount of food you are sending in for your child's morning snack. The snack table is open from 8:30 to 10:30, with children helping themselves to their snack from their cubby and sitting with friends while they eat. Some children are spending 30 minutes or more eating snack each day and missing out on valuable class work time.

Rescheduled Calendar Days Everyone should have received an updated version of our School Events Calendar. If you did not, more are located on the sign-in/out bookshelf. This calendar reflects the changes that were made following our recent weeklong closure due to Covid.

The Family Fun Event that was supposed to happen on Friday, 10/28 will now just be an in-class fun event and we will not be closing early that day, as originally planned. The children will enjoy some Fall / Halloween themed activities during the morning and we will share a special treat for snack. You do not need to send in a morning snack that day.

Sharing Items from Home As we move deeper into the school year, we're going to start encouraging the children to bring in items to share at circle time that relate to our curriculum studies.

Right now we are learning about fall (trees, leaves, seasonal changes), maps/directions and the 7 continents, secondary colors (orange, purple, green), and the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates.

Children can bring in pictures, realistic toy animals, or books that relate to our science, geography, and art topics. Nothing valuable or delicate, please. All items will be shared at circle and returned home.

Friendly Reminders

- Please write the date on your child's lunch bag every morning. Tape is located in the basket above the lunch bag shelf.
- Children should be bringing their beige "cubby bags" to school each day with their water bottle and snack inside. These bags should be brought into the classroom, not left on their coat hook.
- 3. Nap blankets and toys go home on Fridays and should be returned, clean, on Mondays.
- 4. Children need to be signed in and out each day.
- If there is a change to your child's schedule, please write a note in the yellow notebook at the sign-in shelf, or send an email with the change.
